James Sweering's bright new arrangement brings out the best in the most famous of Karl King's marches. Stirring melodies and counter melodies made King a "tunesmith" like no other.

### Russian Sailor's Dance by Reinhold Gliere

The Red Poppy or sometimes 'The Red Flower' is a ballet in three acts and an apotheosis; score written by Reinhold Gliere and a scenario by Mikhail Kurliko. This ballet was created in 1927 as the first Soviet ballet with a modern revolutionary theme. Possibly the most famous dance from this ballet is the Sailors Dance, sometimes referred to as the 'Russian Sailors Dance'. It is this selection for which Gliere is perhaps best known.

### A Festival Prelude by Alfred Reed

A Festival Prelude was written in commemoration of the twenty-fifth anniversary of the Tri-State Music Festival, held annually in Enid, Oklahoma.

It was given its first performance on that occasion by the Phillips University Concert Band, to whom it is dedicated, with the composer conducting.

While still in manuscript, it was widely performed throughout the country, and has come to be regarded as one of this composer's most brilliant and powerful works for the modern concert band

### Concord by Clare Grundman

Concord is based on three traditional tunes from old New England:

"The White Cockade," William Billings' "America," and "Yankee Doodle."

"The White Cockade" is a file and drum marching tune widely known during the days of the American Revolution. "America" was written by William Billings (1746-1800), an ardent patriot, amateur musician, and farmer by trade. "Yankee Doodle" is the folk song most widely associated with the Revolutionary War. It had spread throughout the colonies by the mid-eighteenth century, and was very popular as a tune for jigs and country dances.

### Esprit de Corps by Robert Jager

Esprit de Corps is the second Robert Jager work commissioned by the United States Marine Band (the first being Tableaux). Based on The Marine's Hymn, Esprit De Corps is a kind of fantasy march, as well as a tribute to the United States Marine Band and a salute to the Marine Corps in general. Full of energy and drama, the composition has both solemn and light moments. While Esprit De Corps is a tribute to the Marine Band, it is also a display piece for any fine group of band musicians.

### Pineapple Poll, Mvrs I-IV by Charles Mackerras

As Sir Charles Mackerras writes in the booklet notes, the idea of transforming the eminently danceable tunes of the Gilbert and Sullivan comic operas into a ballet score occurred to him while he was playing in the orchestra for a Gilbert and Sullivan season in Australia. Pineapple Poll was first performed, with immediate success, in March 1951 at Sadler's Wells Theatre. Although Mendelssohn and Schubert are obvious influences, the freshness of Sullivan's melodic gifts, as well as his technical fluency, are abundantly evident.

### Tam O'Shanter by Malcolm Arnold

The composer regards Robert Burns as one of the greatest of poets, and has expressed the hope that his own enjoyment of the work of the remarkable Scotsman, as reflected in this music, will encourage others to read him. The overture has a well-defined programme, though one's response to it is by no means wholly dependent on the literary background.
